The central responsibility of the REACH Volunteers Core is to utilize strategies and techniques (learned through training) to provide a safe and supportive summer camp environment for campers with special needs.

Eligibility Requirements

- ◆ Volunteers must be at least 15 years of age (high school only).
- ◆ Volunteers must have an interest in working with campers with disabilities.
- ◆ Volunteers must be able to accept supervision and guidance.
- ◆ Volunteers must be enthusiastic, possess a sense of humor and have patience.
- ◆ Volunteers must be available to attend Camp Orientation.
- ◆ Volunteers must be available to commit to the entire summer.
- ◆ Camp dates: July 3—August 11, 2017—6 weeks.
- ◆ Monday—Friday from 8:15 a.m.—4:00 p.m.
- ◆ Additional session: August 14—18, 2017 (optional & upon invitation from Director)
